I. Team Ministry Spiritual Gifts Inventory.

A. Evangelism

Definition: Those gifted by God to proclaim the gospel to the unsaved

General References: Eph. 4:11

B. Prophecy

Definition: Those who spoke under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, bringing a message from God to the church, and whose main motivation and concern were with the spiritual life and purity of the church

General References: Rom. 12:6; I Cor. 12:10; 14:1-33; Eph. 4:11; I Thes. 5:20-21; I Tim. 1:18; I Pet. 4:11; I John 4:1-3

C. Teaching

Definition: Those gifted to clarify and explain God's Word in order to build up the church

General References: Rom. 12:7; Eph. 4:11-12, Col. 3:16; I Tim. 3:2; 5:17; II Tim. 2:2,24

D. Exhortation

Definition: Those gifted to motivate other Christians to a deeper faith and dedication to Christ, a fuller manifestation of the fruit of the Holy Spirit, and a more complete separation from the world.

General References: Rom. 12:8; I Cor. 14:3; I Thes. 5:11, 14-22; Heb. 10:24-25

E. Pastor /Shepherding

Definition: Those chosen and gifted to oversee the church and care for its spiritual needs

General References: Acts 14:23; 15:1-6, 22-23; 16:4; 20:17-38;
Rom. 12:8; Eph. 4:11-12; Phil. 1:1; I Tim. 3:1-7; 5:17-20;
Tit. 1:5-9; Heb. 13:17; I Pet. 5:1-5

G. Serving

Definition: Those gifted for a variety of helpful deeds

General References: I Cor. 12:28

H. Giving

Definition: Those gifted to give freely of their resources far beyond the tithe to the needs of God's people.

General References: Acts 2:44-45; 4:34-35; 11:29-30; I Cor. 16:1-4; II Cor. 8-9; Eph. 4:28; I Tim. 6:17-19; Heb. 13:16; I John 3:16-18

I. Administration

Definition: Those gifted to guide and oversee the various activities of the church

General References: I Cor. 12:7; Eph. 4:11-12; I Tim. 3:1-7;
Heb. 13:7-17,24
