Matthew 20:20-28

Verse 28 - "Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many."

# What is Servant Hood?

Secular Leadership - Leadership models used in the business world.

- Shouldn't be used by leaders in ministry
- Dangerous on so many different levels

# Biblical Servant Leadership

- We put our agenda last
- Have the confidence to serve
- Don't wait to be served
- Not position-conscious
- Serves out of Love

- Greatest need of the church today
- Holds our way of life together
- Cornerstone of ministry
- It allows others to trust you

## According to Scripture...

- Psalms 15:4 - Keeps his oath even when it hurts
- Galatians 5:22 - Faithfulness
- Proverbs 10:9 - Walks securely
- Proverbs 20:7 - Leads a blameless life

# Integrity

Let's take the Integrity Test...

- How well do I treat people?
- Am I transparent with others?
- Do I role-play based on who I'm with?
- Am I the same person all the time?
- Do I quickly admit wrongdoing?



# Integrity

## Integrity Test continues...

- Do I put other people first?
- Do circumstances determine my choices?
- Do I make difficult decisions?
- Do I talk to People or about them?
- Am I accountable to someone?

# A Visionary and A Vision

- Many people have the concept of vision in leadership wrong
- People don't follow worthy causes just because
- They follow worthy leaders who promote worthwhile causes

# A Visionary continues...

- No vision, no ability to lead
- Events can be a force that drive you away from the vision
- This can open the door for confusion
- It's what the enemy wants!

# A Visionary continues...

“Vision is the ability to imagine an attractive and exciting future for a group of people and uniting them for a common cause as God has mandated for the specific ministry.”

# A Visionary continues...

A vision is not:

- A dream
- A goal or objective
- A purpose or a mission

# A Visionary continues...

- A vision is clear
- A vision is challenging
- A vision is a picture people can envision
- A vision is the ministry's future

# A Visionary continues...

Look at these vision guidelines:

- A vision can be attained
- A vision must be attained - a sense of urgency
- A vision is mandated and approved by God

# A Visionary continues...

Things that may hinder the vision:

- Limited Leaders
- Limited Thinkers
- Bigmouth Talkers
- Continual Losers
- Satisfied Sitters



# A Visionary continues...

Things that may hinder the vision:

- Traditional Lovers
- Census Takers
- Problem Perceivers
- Self-Seekers
- Failure Forecaster

# A Visionary continues...

Three things we must do: Catch a Vision,  
Own the Vision and Spread the Vision!

- The leader must own the vision
- The leader must understand the audience

# A Visionary continues...

- The leader needs to use expressive language
- The leader should speak positively
- The leader must speak with charisma
- The leader needs to speak with conviction
