Greetings! And welcome back to another exciting edition of The Christian Global Harvest! I pray that you are well and richly blessed.

Let's continue exploring the attitudes we should have toward one another. We have already covered **Love, Cooperation, Appreciation for Others and Their Work, Submissiveness, and Peaceableness**. Let's look at a few more, starting with **Hospitality**.

Hospitality should be high on our list because we are called to be hospitable, according to **Romans 12:13**. "...given to hospitality." This includes both hospitality to strangers and to the saints. I love what **Hebrews 13:2** says: "**Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.**" I wonder how many of us have failed to be hospitable to angels since we have been saved?

Perhaps you'll agree that a factor in the rapid spread of the church in the first century was the hospitality extended by the Christians, particularly during Pentecost (refer to the Book of Acts). Meanwhile, **3 John 5-7** declares: "**Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers; (6) Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well: (7) Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.**"

Next I believe we should be Warm, Friendly, and Open. And we can see this expressed by those in the early church at Jerusalem, according to **Acts 2:44-47**. "**And all that believed were together, and had all things common; (45) And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need.**

(46) And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, (47) Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved." Praise God! He does great things when we are on one accord!

Also, Gentleness and Meekness play a vital role as well. They are especially necessary in dealing with the spiritually weak, according to **Galatians 6:1**. They are also helpful in dealing with those who oppose us, according to **2 Timothy 2:24-26**.

Lastly, our attitude should consist of Forgiveness, Forbearance, Patience, and Long-suffering. All of these overlap and are very important, according to **Ephesians 4:2, 32**. They really help smooth out the turbulence and obstacles that Satan will put in our way in his effort to destroy the local church.

Parting Words from The Publisher




