Let’s continue our study on the attitudes that are so desperately needed to accomplish church work. In case you missed it, we have already discussed the attitudes we need toward ourselves. Now we want to explore the attitudes we should have toward our brethren. After all, we are in this together. Therefore, let’s start with **Love**.

Jesus taught us the necessity of loving our brethren. He says in **John 13: 34-35**, “A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. (35) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.” Notice the transference of Love. It’s not *for* another but it’s *to* another. There is a difference here.

Moreover, we have been born again that we might love one another fervently. Listen to what **1 Peter 1:22-23** says, “Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: (23) Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.”

It’s clear that we are commanded to love our brethren genuinely and fervently. We can do it because the Word commands it.

And if we truly love one another, how can we not work together? Great question! Well, let’s begin with **cooperation**. This involves a willingness to work together as God would have us to do. The Scriptures uses the human body to express this cooperation. **1 Corinthians 12:21** declares, “And the eye cannot say unto the

hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.”

Saints, we need to be able not only to work, but also to work together in love!

Andrew Carnegie, a self-made steel tycoon and one of the wealthiest businessmen of the 19th century, stated that, “It marks a big step in a man’s development when he comes to realize that other men can be called on to help him do a better job than he can do alone.”

Know this: Where there is cooperation, a good way of doing things will be more productive than a better way of doing things where cooperation does not exist!

If we are going to be effective as a congregation, we must work together. Our relationship must be harmonious and pleasing to the Lord.

With sincere gratitude, we thank you for your support and participation in making this event a huge success. We look forward to fellowshipping with you again real soon. God bless you!






First Lady Classie Reeder
